

Instructions for Authors – SMPS 2026

General Information

Papers must be between 6 and 8 pages. Additional pages will be subject to extra charges. Since the proceedings of SMPS 2026 will be published by Springer Nature, submissions have to be written in L^AT_EX using the style contained in the zip-folder `contributions_SMPS2026.zip`.

Preparation of Manuscripts

- Copy the files contained in the zip file to your working directory.
- It is recommended to update MiKTeX in order to get the latest bug fixes and package updates.
- Use the template `author_SMPS2026.tex` (which includes the Springer document class `svproc.cls`) to write your article, run L^AT_EX and produce your own PDF.
- See `quickstart.pdf` for an easy implementation of the `svproc` package.
- For a description of other useful packages and SVProc class options, special commands and environments, see `refguide.pdf`.
- For detailed instructions on text, mathematics, references, figures, and tables, see `authinst.pdf`.

Manuscript Structure

- The first manuscript page should contain the title, author(s) names (including affiliations), a short running title, and full addresses of the corresponding author (including email and postal address).

- Each paper must include a short abstract (maximum 200 words) summarizing the content.
- Text, formulas, figures, and tables should be typed using standard L^AT_EX commands. Standard sectioning commands may be used.
- For theorems, definitions, examples, etc., the SVProc document class provides predefined environments. Please, do not include new definitions (`\newenvironment`, `\newcommand`, or `\def`).
- Always use `\label` and `\ref` for cross-referencing.

Figures and Tables

- Figures should be numbered consecutively with captions below the figure. Use EPS format with embedded fonts for L^AT_EX; for pdfL^AT_EX use PNG, JPEG, or PDF.
- Colour figures will be converted to grayscale for printing.
- Tables should be numbered separately with captions above or below. Ensure every table is preceded by a caption.

References

- References may be cited by number (preferred) or author/year.
- Reference lists should be sorted alphabetically. Use `\cite` and `\bibitem` for cross-referencing.
- If using BiBTeX, use the Springer Nature style `spbasic.bst`.
- Include complete and up-to-date bibliographic information.
- For multiple works by the same author, order as follows:
 1. Works by the author alone, chronologically.
 2. Works by the author with a coauthor, alphabetically by coauthor.
 3. Works by the author with multiple coauthors, chronologically.
- Use standard journal name abbreviations according to the ISSN List: <http://www.issn.org/2-22661-LTWA-online.php>

Using Third-Party Materials

Authors are responsible for obtaining permissions for third-party content. Use the Rights Holder website or Copyright Clearance Center. If rights-holder forms are provided, ensure they include all required rights.

Contributor Agreement

All authors must grant Springer Nature permission to publish the work. Once the manuscript is accepted, the corresponding author should print, complete, and sign the Contributor Agreement form with chapter title and authors' names. Details must match the manuscript exactly; changes cannot be accepted later.
